### ELECTION NOTICE

You will find your election ballot on the reverse side of this page.

Ballots may be cast in one of two ways:

- **In Person**: Ballots may be cast at the ballot box at the RUSTLERS dance on November 27<sup>th</sup>. Your name will be checked off the roster eligibility list as your ballot is cast.
- **Absentee**: Absentee ballots are to be mailed in two envelopes. The completed ballot is sealed in an unmarked envelope. That envelope is then sealed inside a second outer envelope. **On the outside of the second envelope, show your name and return address** in the upper left hand corner (Envelopes without a return name and address will not be counted as valid). Absentee ballots must be received no later than November 27<sup>th</sup> at the address shown below.

The ballot on the reverse side of this page is designed for up to two (2) members who share a newsletter. Select one person (couple) for each office. Write-in votes are accepted for any office listed on the ballot. To vote for a candidate, mark an **X** in the box in front of that candidate’s name.

To vote for a write-in candidate, please print the candidate’s name on the blank line under the office for which you are voting. *It is the responsibility of the person writing in a candidate to make certain that the candidate will accept the office for which he or she is being written in.*
